I. Immediate Contacts

II. Water System Facilities

- A. Water Storage Tank 250,000 glassed lined water tank located at Town Highway Garage, Chapman Road, Montezuma, NY

III. Specific Emergency Response

- A. Pump or chlorinator failure (due to mechanical or electrical problems).
1. Notify the Cayuga County Health Dept.
 2. Electrician: John Abraham (315) 707-4377
 3. Plumber: Wellington Plumbing (315) 776-9647
 4. Standby spare parts are available at the Highway Garage, Chapman Rd., Montezuma, NY
 5. Boil Water Order/Advisory – Notification of residents will be made by reverse 911, Citizen newspaper, Local TV Stations, Town website: <http://townofmontezuma.org>; Facebook: <https://www.facebook.com/MontezumaNY/>; door to door, if necessary
 6. Bulk Water – List of New York State certified bulk water haulers & list of locations for distribution.

- B. Power Failure
1. A portable emergency generator is available at or through Montezuma Fire Department: Chief - (315) 406-9483 in the event of power failure.
 2. Call appropriate power company, NYSEG at 1-800-572-1131.
 3. Call Cayuga County Health Dept. at 315-253-1405.

4. A Boil Water Order will be implemented if there is any disruption of chlorination or a loss of pressure of 4 hours or more. Notification of residents will be made by (See #5 above).
- C. Contamination of Source (floods, chemical spills, etc.)
1. Notify Cayuga County Health Dept.
 2. Discontinue source use or when advisable issue boil water order.
 3. Provide notification to residents by (see #5 above).
 4. Consider emergency source alternatives.
 - a. List alternative sources such as back up sources, interconnections, bulk water, etc. (see bulk water #6)

IV. Water Conservation Measures

The following steps will be taken to conserve water:

1. Notification to consumers of water conservation.
2. Limit car washing, lawn watering, etc.
3. List of large consumers to be contacted. — N/A
