COVID-19 Vaccine Update

Cayuga County is running clinics for those residents with qualifying health conditions. If you have a qualifying health condition, the Health Department asks that you contact ***the Montezuma Town Clerk's office at 315-776-8844***, for your name to be added to the list. If you have to leave a message, please provide your name, address and a call back phone number.

The Town Clerk's office will not be asking to see proof of qualifying health condition. All qualifying health condition documentation required for an appointment will be given to the Health Department upon arrival to the clinic. Additionally, as a matter of security for people interested in utilizing this service, it is important to remember, no person will be asked to share their social security number and there is no cost to receive the vaccine.

A note from your health care provider with qualifying health conditions will be required. The Town Clerk's office in Montezuma is currently collecting names of residents to be included on a vaccine waiting list for COVID-19 vaccines **available to only people with certain underlying health conditions outlined by the state as qualifying under the current prioritization schedule.**

The list of eligible conditions includes cancer (either current or in remission), chronic kidney disease, diabetes, heart conditions, intellectual and developmental disabilities, neurological conditions (Alzheimer's disease or dementia), liver disease, cerebrovascular disease, sickle cell disease, severe obesity with a body mass index of at least 40 or obesity with a BMI of 30 or higher, pregnancy and pulmonary disease.

When making an appointment, there are some health-related questions that need to be answered, if anyone is not comfortable giving that information to the Town Clerk, they will be directed to local pharmacies or the NYS Mass Vaccination Site at the Fairgrounds.

The health department is asking that residents begin contacting their health care provider to get the paperwork process started. The eligibility documentation can be in the form of:

- a note on the health care provider's letterhead (including patient name, date of birth and list their health conditions that qualifies them)
- a visit summary note w/ health conditions listed, summary note must be from a visit within the past twelve months
- or a print off from the electronic health record portal with the necessary information

No individual will be allowed to receive the vaccine without qualifying documentation. The Health Department will be keeping the qualifying documentation for auditing purposes.

If you are 65 years of age or older, your age makes you eligible to receive the vaccine at a local pharmacy or state vaccination site, but not at a health department clinic.

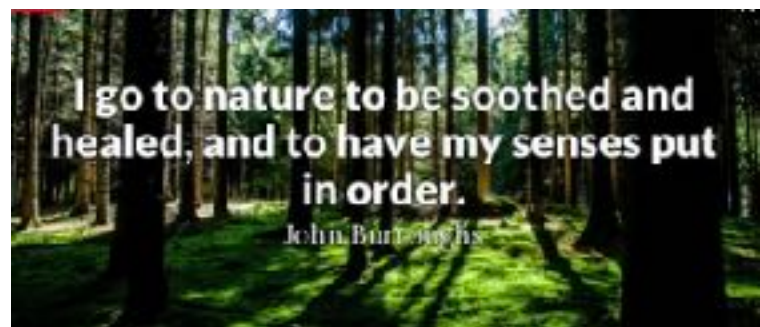
