## **Broadband Issues Addressed in CNY**

The Town of Montezuma's Comprehensive Plan includes several goals and recommendations that residents identified important. One of these goals was access to community-wide broadband.

To help address internet access issues in Central New York, the Central New York Regional Planning and Development Board (CNY RPDB) is helping to identify areas in the region that are unserved or underserved with affordable internet access.

There are separate surveys for residents and businesses. To participate, please select the county button where your home and/ or business resides. If you run a business from your home, fill out both a residential and a business survey to help identify your unique needs.

The confidential information collected from this survey will be used to identify areas in the region most in need of improved internet access service. The information will also provide a basis for developing a plan that will be used to improve broadband internet access in each county. This study will help determine the cost of improving broadband internet access in Central New York. It will also serve as the basis to seek federal and state government grants to support implementation of a public-private partnership to offset the costs of deploying broadband services.

If you know someone who wants to participate but does not have internet access, please have them contact the **CNY RPDB at (315) 412-5966 for assistance.** If necessary, a survey will be mailed to them directly.
