## New York State Low Income Household Water Assistance Program

#### Do you need help paying for overdue water and wastewater bills?

The Low Income Household Water Assistance Program (LIHWAP) can help.

LIHWAP is a drinking water and wastewater emergency assistance program funded through new federal resources. Benefits are based on the amount of unpaid water and wastewater bills owed by applicants. This assistance is targeted at low income households and income guidelines will mirror that of the Home Energy Assistance Program.

LIHWAP benefits are based on the actual amount of drinking water and/or wastewater arrears, up to a maximum of \$2,500 per drinking water or wastewater provider, or \$5,000 if drinking water and wastewater services are combined, per household. Benefits are paid directly to the household's drinking water and/or wastewater vendor(s).

Eligibility and benefits are based on:

- income,
- household size,
- household includes a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or qualified alien, and
- amount owed to drinking water and/or wastewater provider(s).

Primary applicants must provide:

- Proof of identity
- Proof of residence
- Documentation of earned and unearned income
- A drinking water, wastewater, or combined drinking water and wastewater bill listing their permanent and primary residence
- A valid Social Security Number (SSN)
  - SSNs of additional household members will be requested

### **Important Water Survey**

The letter below was recently sent to property owners in the Town of Montezuma. It is important that you return the completed survey in order to determine what residences are in need of public water supply.

Dear Resident:

The Town Board of Montezema has been receiving requests from residents to look into providing public water in various areas of the Town. As a result of these requests, the Town has decided to implement this questionnaire in your area. The results of this questionnaire will be used to determine if and where to begin the next step in the process to form a new water service area, if there is sufficient interest.

We realize that this type of project could be a sizeable undertaking, and the Town would need State and/or Federal funding to allow for a reasonable cost. Typically, this type of project is got paid for through town-wide property taxes, but instead via water billings to those properties that are within the project area. Therefore, it is very important that we receive the highest number of resident responses possible.

Overall, this questionnaire will assist us in evaluating your situation, problems, and/or most importantly your comments. It will also assist us in identifying if your area is in need of public water systems.
