- 2024 Property Tax Payment Schedule
 - January 1st through <u>April 1st, 2024</u> Monday thru Friday,
 11:00am until 2:00pm except Wednesday January 10,
 February 14, and March 13

Taxpayers are encouraged to pay by check, money order, or official check made payable to Montezuma Tax Collector and mail payments to P.O. Box 357, Montezuma NY 13117.

When paying in person with cash please bring the exact amount if possible. If you are unable to make your payment during the scheduled tax collection office hours please call 315-776-8844, ext. 4, during office hours, or 315-776-8583 to schedule an appointment.

Payments made by Bill Payment Checks from a processing center must be physically received on or before the due date shown on the tax bill for full payment, first installment, full payment with 1% penalty or full payment with 2% penalty based on the postmark rule application.

Tax payments sent via privately metered mail are not postmarks and are considered paid upon receipt. Payments not physically received by the due date will be returned.
