Temporary Assistance Program

Temporary Assistance is a program for temporary financial help for needy men, women and children. If you are unable to work, can't find a job, or your paycheck does not meet your everyday expenses, TA may be able to help you.

 Emergency Assistance: for households that are facing emergencies through no fault of their own, due to a sudden and unexpected event or loss of income.

◆TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families): for households with children.

✤ Safety Net Assistance: for single people or couples without children (there is a 45-day wait for assistance in this program)

✤ Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP): a onetime benefit program designed to help low-income households pay for their energy costs. This program generally runs from November to March

 <u>Tax Collector Office Hours — Open through April 1st, 2024</u> – <u>Monday thru Friday, 11:00am until 2:00pm – except February</u> <u>14, and March 13</u>

Taxpayers are encouraged to pay by check, money order, or official check made payable to <u>Montezuma Tax Collector and</u> <u>mail payments to P.O. Box 357, Montezuma NY 13117.</u> When paying in person with cash please bring the EXACT amount if possible. If you are unable to make your payment during the scheduled tax collection office hours please call 315-776-8844, ext. 4, during office hours, or 315-776-8583 to schedule an appointment. —Donna Burleton, Tax Collector

Payments made by Bill Payment Checks from a processing center must be physically received on or before the due date shown on the tax bill for full payment, first installment, full payment with 1% penalty or full payment with 2% penalty based on the postmark rule application. Tax payments sent via privately metered mail are not postmarks and are considered paid upon receipt. Payments not physically received by the due date will be returned.
