Celebrate Earth Day by Doing Good on the Canalway in 2024!

On **April 20, 1820,** the packet boat *The Montezuma* arrived in Syracuse marking the beginning of navigation on the Erie Canal's 96-mile middle section between Utica and Montezuma. Now over 200 years later an ErieCanal2025 Partnership Coalition has been formed to recognize and commemorate the upcoming 200th Erie Canal Bicentennial. Plans are being made leading up to the 2025 completion at canal-related sites in communities all along our middle section of the canal system. It is an opportunity to recognize the importance of building the Canal between 1817 and 1825 as the longest artificial waterway and the greatest public works project in North America.

Coinciding with this April date, on **Earth Day** several of our local partners are joining the 140 statewide Canal Clean Sweep events with opportunities for thousands of residents to give back to our local communities and to show pride in one of New York's most iconic cultural and recreational resources.

Announcing New Historical Society Merger

In late February Port Byron Lock 52 and Montezuma historical socieites combined into one organization chartered through the NYS Education Department. Now named the Old Mentz Heritage Center, the mission of both groups has been and will continue to be to preserve the history of our reg;ion and to help to educate those who wish to learn about it. There has always been a common thread with the towns of Montezuma and Throop being originally formed within the township of Mentz until 1859. The Old Mentz Heritage Center is located at 73 Pine Street in Port Byron where meetings, collections, displays and programs will be held by the newly formed group.

Volunteers from Montezuma's Society will continue to help the Town maintain trails, interpret the historic sites and offer tours. A trust fund has been set up to continue its support. Collections, digital newspapers and online family geneology records are being carefully preserved by volunteers that contributes to the ongoing story of our communities.
