# **Family History Month**

Since the dawn of time, family histories have been significant, and it has only increased in recent years. The family histories of individuals tell us who we are, where we originated from, and which notable relatives we may have descended from. Learning the history of our ancestors helps us gain a greater understanding of the challenges we have faced, and it often inspires greater love and compassion for our flaws and mistakes. This compassion can easily translate to our relationships with the living, within our families, and outside them.

Family History Month is celebrated every October. It is a terrific opportunity to enhance your genealogy abilities, learn about new resources, and meet people who share your interests.

Old Mentz Heritage Center (OMHC) is celebrating the month with a display at the Port Byron Library. You can visit the window display at the library which will feature a displayed quilt made by Celestia Kerns estimated to have been made in the 1860s. Celestia and her husband operated a grocery store along the Canal near Lock 52 for fifty years in Port Byron. Their daughter



married Jonathan Myers and she lived in Montezuma and Port Byron for several years before moving to Syracuse.

Learning and documenting your family history gives you a sense of identity and a better understanding who you. Researching local family histories is made more easy with an extensive database created by Kathy Decker. She has dedicated hours to indexing the Montezuma Family Project database and is currently working on a Mentz Project, now with over 20,000 entries.
