

REMEMBERING BILL BREEN



The Town of Montezuma will dedicate a memorial plaque to honor the memory of one its longtime residents on April 19th on Earth Day following its Volunteer Canal Clean Sweep Day in Montezuma Heritage Park. The plaque was donated from raffle proceeds held by Dan Dennis of Just Breathe Fingerlakes to honor Charles "Bill" Breen. Bill passed away at the age of 93 on January 12, 2025, and springtime graveside burial services

will be held on April 19th in Savannah-Butler Cemetery at 11 AM with full military honors.

Following the services a Celebration of Life will be held at the Montezuma Fire Department on High Street. Prior to the gathering at the firehouse, the plaque will be dedicated where it will be placed on a tree along the High Street Byron Lapp Trailhead next to a bird house made by Bill. Bill was an avid outdoorsman with an appreciation for nature. He often road his bike in the park, and could be seen fondly in the neighborhood often walking and riding along country roads. He was a talented natural woodworking artist frequently seen in his garage making his latest creation from natural pieces gathered in the woods until his most recent illness. Bill had a great passion for hunting and trapping started at an early age taught by some of the best hunters and trappers in Montezuma.

Born in Savannah, he served in the Army in Bamberg, Germany during WWII. Following the war he moved to Montezuma and became a self-employed carpenter. He is survived by his daughter, Laura and grandson Michael Powers, and was predeceased by his wife Barbara.
